Story comprehension

Ask your child the following questions.

Before reading:

This book is a recipe. Do you know what a recipe is?

Look at the picture on the title page. What do you think the girl is going to make?

(predicting)

Where in your house might you make pancakes? (making connections)

During reading:

How many eggs does the girl use? (See page 8.)

What does she use to mix the eggs, flour and milk? (See page 9.)

What do we know about the pan? (See page 10.)

After reading:

What things do you need to make pancakes? (summarising)

What might the girl put on her pancakes? (inferring)

What do you like to put on your pancakes? (making connections)

Phonics focus Go to page 9. Ask your child to find the word beginning with the /qu/ sound.

Ask them if they can think of any other words beginning with the /qu/ sound. Go to page 11. Ask your child to find the word ending with the /x/ sound. Ask them if they can think of any other words ending with the /x/ sound.


